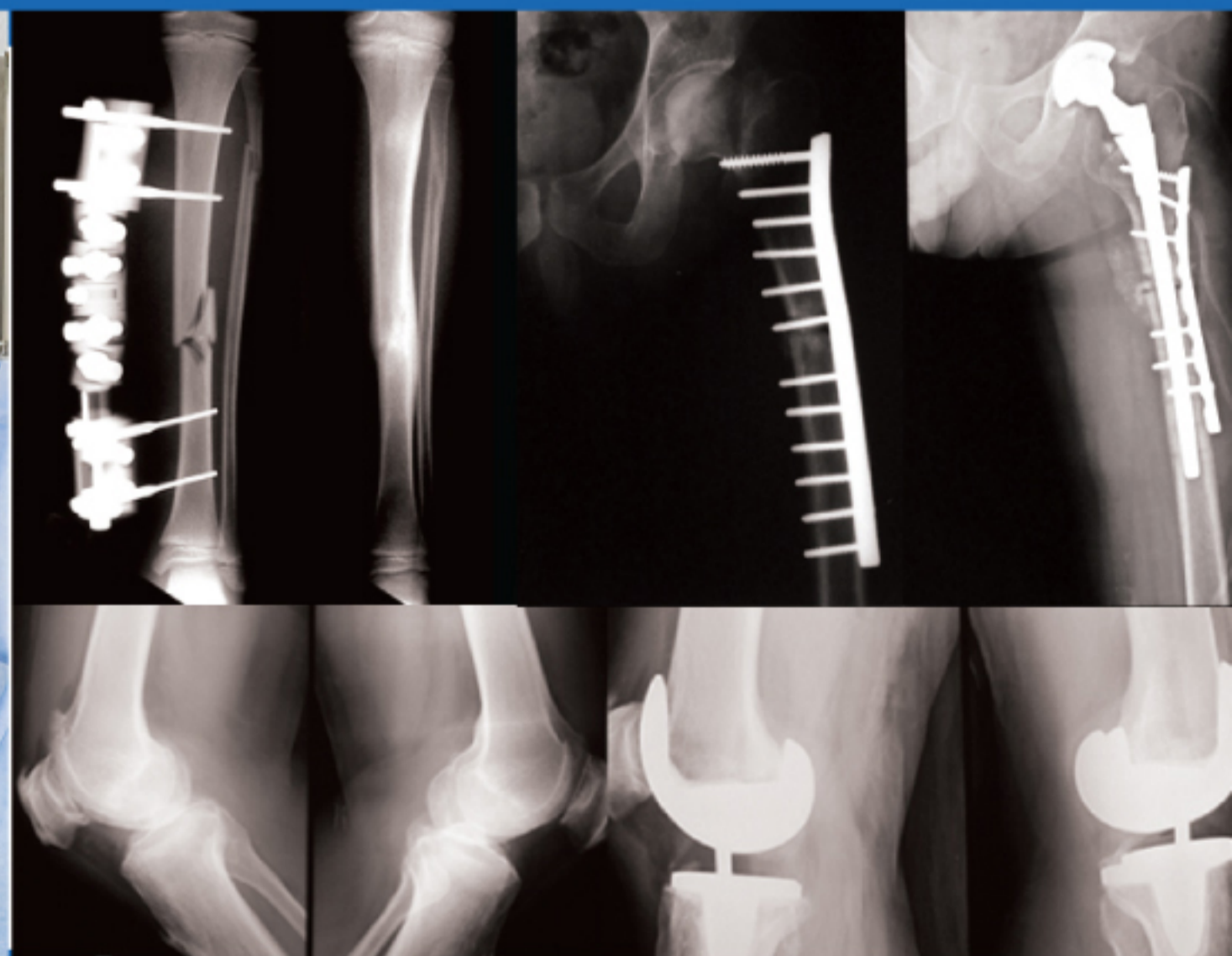

Bhojtal - The largest artificial lake in Asia



Bhopal, capital of Madhya Pradesh combines scenic beauty, historicity and modern urban planning. Often called the Heart of India, Madhya Pradesh is the second largest state located in the centre of India.

Bhopal houses various institutions and installations of national importance. Some of these include ISRO's Master Control Facility, the CSIR Advanced Materials and Processes Research Institute (AMPRI), Maulana Azad National Institute of Technology, IISER Bhopal, School of Planning and Architecture, Indian Institute of Forest Management, BHEL, Gandhi Medical College and the AIIMS (under construction). The city attracted international attention after the Bhopal disaster, when a Union Carbide India Limited (UCIL) pesticide manufacturing plant leaked a mixture of deadly gases including methyl isocyanate on the intervening night of 2 / 3 December 1984, leading to the worst industrial disaster in the history of industrialization and a loss of thousands of lives.



Bhopal is known as the City of Lakes for its various natural as well as artificial lakes. Bhojtal - The largest artificial lake in Asia (formerly known as Upper Lake) is said to be constructed by the King Bhoja. Few of the places of interest in Bhopal includes: Taj-ul-Masajid - one of the largest mosque in Asia; Manav Sanghralay - A place near upper lake where you find old cultures and traditions; Van Vihar - This safari-park is located

on a hill adjacent to the Upper Lake; Manuabhan Ki Tekri - A Jain temple, situated on a hill cliff, this place is popular for the scenic views it offers of the city below and many more.



Peoples College of Medical Science and Research Centre - affiliated to Barkut-ul-lah University was established as a teaching hospital in 2002 and started its MBBS admission in 2005. Spread over an area of about 40 acres, its associated hospital has 830 beds at present which would be increased to 1128 beds shortly. The college is about 5.5 Kms from the Airport and 6.5 kms from the Bhopal Railway Station.
